## **Deaconess**



## Glendale Seventh-day Adventist Church

A Deaconess is called by God, elected by the congregation and ordained as a limited extension of the pastoral ministry at Glendale Seventh-day Adventist Church. As a Board of Deaconesses, they are led by the Head Deaconess who also serves on the Church Board.

## Accountability

- 1. Meet as a **Board of Deaconesses** on a quarterly basis or more often as needed to ensure the efficiency and effectiveness of the deaconess ministry.
- 2. Head Deaconess to serve the Church Board on a monthly basis.

## Responsibilities

- 1. **Assist** with **fellowship meals** and **funeral receptions** as required to warm up and serve food, cover tables with tablecloths, wash dishes and clean the kitchen.
- 2. **Assist** with **Baptismal Ceremonies** by preparing robes for all candidates and the Pastor, helping female candidates and laundering the robes after use.
- 3. Assist with Communion Services by preparing and arranging the bread, wine and trays, working with the deacons to set up the rooms for the Ordinance of Humility, serving during Communion and laundering the towels after use.
- 4. **Assist** the Pastors and Elders in **identifying** and **visiting** members and others in need or ministering to them through a card ministry, etc.
- Assist in the maintenance, upkeep and neatness of the facility by checking on and reporting needed repairs and deficiencies to the Head Deacon.
- 6. **Deal with requests for assistance** as appropriate or by referring them to the proper ministries or social service agencies.
- 7. Prepare meals for families of members who are sick or recovering from surgery.
