- 5. Oversee the operation of the Ministry.

 - b. Develop an annual calendar of Ministry activities.
 - c. Promote Ministry events in the Church and larger community.
 - d. Implement programs and activities that address women's needs and concerns.
 - e. Evaluate progress toward the Ministry's goals.
